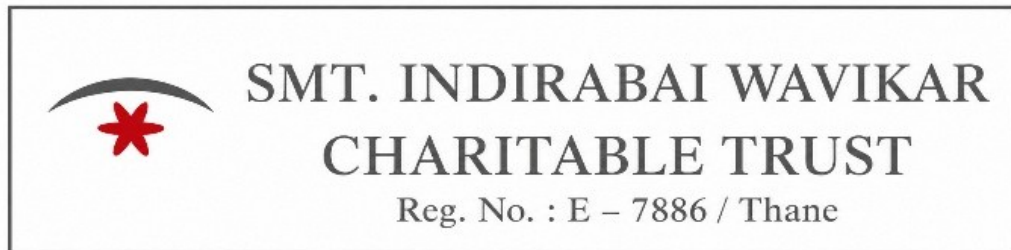

Message from the Chairman

It is my privilege to present the Annual Report of Smt. Indirabai Wavikar Charitable Trust for the year 2020–2021. This report records the Trust's continued commitment to compassionate, accessible and quality eye care through community-oriented services.

During the year, 16 eye camps were conducted and 909 patients were screened. Cataract services accounted for 756 surgeries, including 110 free surgeries and 646 subsidised surgeries. The Trust also distributed 97 spectacles.

The supplied statistics record school children screened as 0 for 2020–2021. This figure is presented as provided and no separate school-screening activity has been assumed.

We remain grateful to patients, healthcare professionals, staff, volunteers, donors, community partners and well-wishers whose support contributes to the Trust's charitable eye-care mission.

Major Activity: Community Eye Camps

During 2020–2021, the Trust conducted 16 community eye camps and screened 909 patients. These camps provided opportunities for eye screening, counselling and identification of patients requiring further evaluation or treatment.

The activity figures supplied for the year are presented without adding or estimating any unreported camp activities.



Major Activity: Cataract Services

Cataract care was a major component of the Trust's reported activity during 2020–2021. A total of 756 cataract surgeries were recorded.

Total cataract surgeries	756
Free surgeries	110
Subsidised surgeries	646

The reported free and subsidised services supported access to cataract treatment for patients requiring financial assistance.



Access to Care: Free & Subsidised Surgeries

The 2020–2021 cataract figures show 756 cataract surgeries, of which 110 were free and 646 were subsidised.

$$756 = 110 \text{ free} + 646 \text{ subsidised}$$

Vision Support: Spectacles Distribution

The Trust distributed 97 spectacles during 2020–2021. Spectacle distribution forms an important part of vision support by helping individuals with identified refractive needs receive appropriate vision correction.

School Vision Screening

The activity data supplied for 2020–2021 records school children screened as 0.

Accordingly, this report does not state that a school screening programme was conducted during the year. The page is retained in the same annual-report structure for consistency and may be updated if verified year-specific records are available.

Major Activity: Diabetic Retinopathy & Glaucoma Screening

The reference annual-report framework identifies diabetic retinopathy and glaucoma screening as important community eye-health activities, with a focus on early detection, counselling and timely intervention.





Awareness & Special Outreach Initiatives

The reference report describes awareness initiatives covering regular eye examinations, preventive eye care, diabetes-related eye diseases, glaucoma, cataracts and childhood vision care. Special outreach is intended to extend services to vulnerable and underserved populations through community and institutional collaboration.



Education, Training & Innovation

Education and capacity building are integral to strengthening community eye care. The reference report highlights the role of Wavikar College of Optometry in developing skilled eye-care professionals through academic learning and clinical exposure.

The reference framework includes practical learning through community eye screening camps, clinical postings, school eye-health initiatives, rural outreach, continuing education programmes, workshops, seminars and guest lectures, together with research, evidence-based practice and public awareness.
