### Message from the Chairman

*It is my privilege to present the Annual Report of Smt. Indirabai Wavikar Charitable Trust for the year 2017-2018. This report reflects our continued commitment to compassionate, accessible and high-quality eye care and our efforts to reach communities with timely screening and treatment.*

*During the year, the Trust conducted 189 eye camps and screened 23,139 patients. Cataract care remained a major area of service, with 965 cataract surgeries recorded, including 272 free surgeries and 693 subsidised surgeries. The Trust also distributed 271 spectacles and screened 12,034 school children.*

*These achievements represent the combined efforts of our doctors, healthcare professionals, staff, volunteers, donors, community partners and well-wishers. Every screening and treatment supported the wider objective of preventing avoidable vision loss and improving quality of life.*

*We remain grateful to the communities we serve for their trust and to everyone who contributes to the Trust's charitable eye-care mission. We look forward to strengthening outreach, education, partnerships and patient-centred care in the years ahead.*

*Community eye camps are a key outreach activity under the reference format. In 2024–2025, 253 eye camps were conducted and 31,772 patients were screened.*

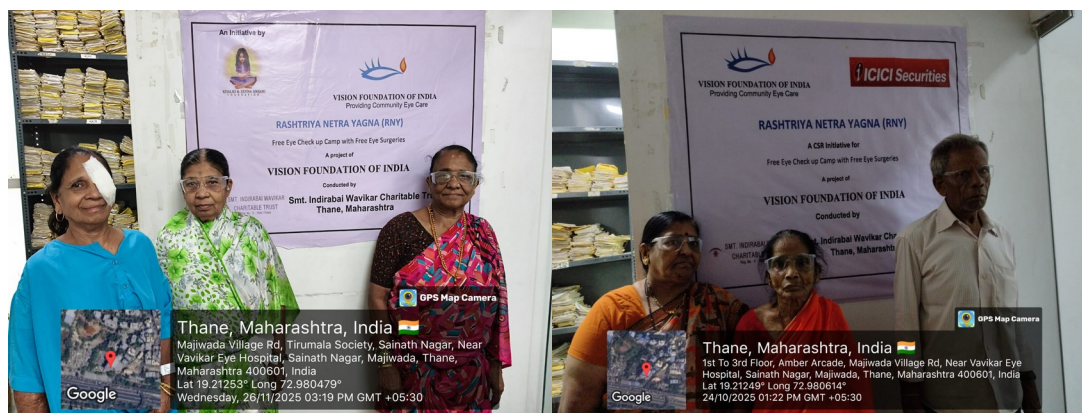


## Major Activity – Cataract Services

Cataract services formed a major part of the year's charitable eye-care activity. The Trust recorded 1,690 cataract surgeries.

## Free & Subsidised Cataract Care

*The Trust's free and subsidised cataract services supported patients who required financial assistance. During 2024–2025, 352 surgeries were free and 1,338 surgeries were subsidised.*

## Major Activity – Spectacles Distribution

*A total of 358 spectacles were distributed during 2024–2025. Spectacle support contributes to improved functional vision for beneficiaries identified through screening and clinical assessment.*

## Major Activity – School Screening

*School screening is identified as a major activity in the Trust's annual-report format. During 2024-2025, 23,987 school children were screened.*
